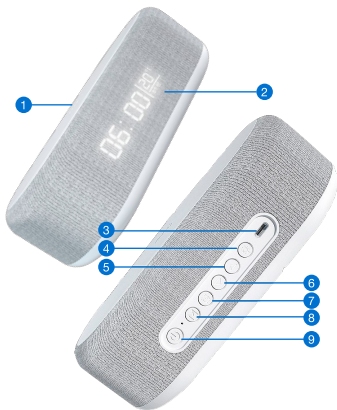




Note: Product illustrations are for reference only and may slightly differ from the actual product without impacting functionality or performance

1. Wireless charging pad

2. LED display

Shows current time, temperature and BT connection status.

3. USB-C® charging port

4. Night Light Button

5. Up Button

6. Down Button

7. Alarm Clock Button

8. Mode Button

9. Power Button

Press and hold for more than 2 seconds to turn the device on/off.

Alarm Clock

1. Setting the Time

- Press the Alarm Clock Button to cycle through time settings in the following order: year > month > day > hour > minute > alarm clock hour > alarm clock minutes > current time. The corresponding LEDs will flash for two seconds on the position of each selected setting.
- When you reach the setting you want to adjust, use the Up and Down buttons to change the value.
- Press the Alarm Clock Button again to move to the next setting or continue cycling until you return to current time.

If no action is taken for 10 seconds, the settings will be saved automatically and the LED display will return to showing the current time.

2. Time Format Switching

Press the Down button to display the current time format for 1 second. While displayed, press the Down button again to toggle between 24h (default) and 12h formats. The clock will automatically update to the selected format.

3. Setting the Alarm

- Follow the steps in Setting the Time to access the alarm clock setting and choose the desired alarm time.
- Press and hold the Alarm Clock Button for more than 2 seconds to turn the alarm on or off.

Notes:

- When turned on, the alarm will sound automatically at the set time. The alarm indicator light will flash while the alarm is sounding.
- Once set and activated, the alarm will sound every day at the same time unless deactivated.
- Press any button to stop the alarm. If no button is pressed, it will stop automatically after 1 minute.
- The alarm status indicator, located on the bottom right of the display panel, shows whether the alarm is currently active.
- The alarm clock is powered by the built-in battery and will remain operational when disconnected from the power adapter, as long as the battery has sufficient charge.

Night Light

- Short-press the Night Light button to cycle through preset lighting modes: Always On > Breathing Light > Music-Responsive > Flashing > Off.
- Quickly double-press the Night Light button to cycle through three brightness levels: High (default), Medium, Low.

BT Connection

Press the Mode button to activate BT mode and pair the speaker with your smartphone. The BT status indicator (bottom right of the display panel) will flash, indicating the speaker is ready to pair. Once paired successfully, the indicator will remain solid.

When playing audio in BT mode:

- Press and hold the Up or Down buttons to increase or decrease the volume.
- Single-press the Up or Down buttons to skip to the next or previous track.

Note:

- BT mode will automatically deactivate if no device is paired within 1 minute.

Charging Pad

The charging pad will wirelessly charge compatible devices placed flat on its surface, even if the speaker is turned off, as long as it is connected to the power adapter.

Notes:

- The wireless charging pad will not operate when the speaker is disconnected from the power adapter.
- When the blue indicator (bottom right of the LED display panel) is on, the charging pad is active.
- Wireless charging performance may vary depending on the phone model and case. Maximum wireless charging power for iPhone® is 7.5W.
